THE SCHOOL

Escuela Campo Alegre (ECA), The American International School, a private, co-educational international school located in Caracas, Venezuela, was founded in 1937. ECA offers a rigorous academic program for 209 students from nursery to grade 12 with an open, non-selective admissions policy. The school is owned by a consortium of multinational companies and employs 41 faculty members, six administrators from thirteen nations.

ECA is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Schools and Colleges (MSA), the Council of International Schools (CIS), and is authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) to offer the Diploma Program.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT BODY

ECA has 68 students in grades 9-12 representing 19 nations with 29% European, 16% Latin American (not including host), 32% US and Canadian, 16% Venezuelan, 2% Asian, 1% Indian and 4% other.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

ECA requires students to complete 26 credits to be eligible for graduation. Credit of 0.5 is awarded for each semester completed with a passing grade of 3 or higher. ECA believes in a well-rounded education with a strong emphasis on academic subjects. Each student is expected to complete the following credit requirements.

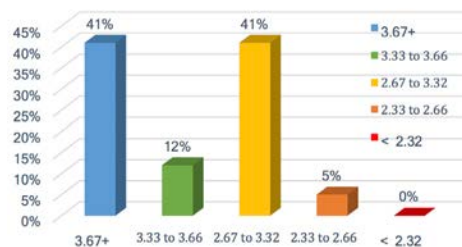
CURRICULUM

ECA offers an international education grounded in the International Baccalaureate program. **English is the medium of instruction at ECA.** All ECA graduates earn a U.S. high school diploma, and approximately 94% of graduates earn the IB Diploma.

GPA DISTRIBUTION FOR THE CLASS OF 2018

GPA is calculated using an average of all courses taken at ECA and is based on a 4.0 scale. All students receive weighted grades (1.0 weight) for up to three IB Higher Level courses maximum. The additional weight is reflected in the cumulative GPA which appears on the transcript. ECA does not rank students.

GRADING SYSTEM

Beginning in Fall 2015, ECA differentiates between Overall Academic Achievement (criterion-referenced performance) and Habits and Attitudes Toward Learning. Overall Academic Achievement marks are now awarded on a 7-1 scale.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA

ECA became a member of the International Baccalaureate Organization in 1992. Diploma and Coursework certificate options are possible. Courses are offered in the following subjects: English (A,B), Spanish (A, B), French (B), Economics, History, Psychology, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, HL & SL Mathematics, and Visual Arts. In the class of 2017, 95% of ECA diploma candidates earned the IB diploma with a mean score of 32. ECA students consistently place well score world averages.

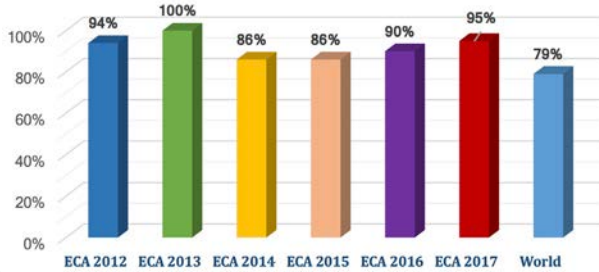

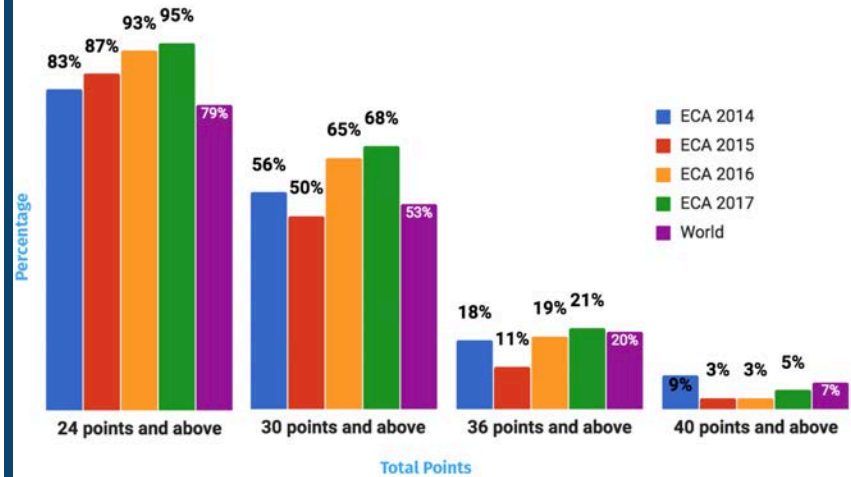
